L3 Program and Workshop – Terri Gage, assumed role on July 16, 2023

- Re-instated the leader rotation system for the weekly programs.
- Organized schedule for rotating leaders for the weekly programs. There were five participants for the rotating system, Krisse Arthur, Terri Gage, Shirley Miller, Claudia Rigg and Dorothy Wood.
- Increased repertoire from 29 to 33 dances.

Special thanks to Krisse for a great job managing L3 Programs and Workshops from January 1 – July 15, 2023. Also want to thank Krisse for creating the L3 Rotation System – Structure and Procedures, a document that has been invaluable to me during transition.

Novice/Novice+ (N/N+) - Anne Romeo, Sponsor

- Welcomed 74 new members in 2023, all of whom came through Novice and most have progressed to N+ and L1. New members primarily hear about us through friends and neighbors. 1Q2024 Novice has 9 new members (& 1 in N+).
- Conducting the N & N+ workshops in quarterly segments is working very well. It clearly indicates when all dances have been taught to both the attendees and the instructors. Although this helps with progression from N to N+, N+ attendees primarily consist of those members who are spotty attenders and need regular refreshing on the dances (This has not caused crowding at N+.).
- Changes to the list of N & N+ dances, per Dance Committee decisions, are implemented with the quarterly boundaries in mind.
 - In N, <u>Lucky Lips</u> replaced <u>Come Dance with Me</u> and in 1Q2024, <u>2 Stepping Away</u> replaces <u>Shuffle Boogie Soul</u>.
 - In N+, <u>Leave!</u> replaced <u>American Kids</u> and in 1Q2024 <u>Little Heartbreak</u> replaces <u>I</u> Close My Eyes.
- With the reduction in the number of co-leaders consistently available, N and N+ co-leading was adjusted to Debby Sullivan being the steady co-leader for N and Jane Sims as the steady co-leader for N+. This eliminated the effort of coordinating a monthly co-leader schedule, and both Debby and Jane willingly covered the opposite workshop as absences occurred. Wall leaders continue to be identified for N and N+, based on interest, capability, and enthusiasm for the club, building bench strength in leaders and instructors. Both N and N+ provide a safe zone for honing skills and building confidence.
 - Effective at the start of 2024, Jane has assumed full responsibility for N+ as the new N+ Sponsor. 4Q2023 N+ was conducted with Jane in the lead for deciding the weekly line-up and in providing primary instruction. Anne acted as co-leader and provided coaching for running N+ throughout the quarter.
 - Identifying a new Novice Sponsor has proved to be more challenging. Several strong candidates are considering the possibility. A co-leader rotation utilizing these candidates may be implemented 1Q2024 to help build their confidence and determine if being more actively involved (teaching, co-leading, and/or sponsoring) with N is something they would like to do. Debby Sullivan will continue to be a steady co-leader and she is actively participating in efforts to identify new N leaders. Anne will continue to be the sponsor until a replacement is identified and comfortable with the responsibility.

The rate of learning seems to increase with each subsequent group. In N, we even introduced the concept of events, with the restart in Lucky Lips, which has proved to work well. Primarily, the dancers are well supported by a clear plan (dances listed in advance on the calendar), wonderful tools (i.e., videos and cue sheets), and leaders surrounding them on the dance floor. Secondly, the dancers appreciate the safe and fun learning environment. Between the practice they do on their own and the camaraderie they enjoy in the workshops, they often ask for more – the next dance, another song, etc. It is humbling to see that their desire to 'do more' has many of them stepping into leadership roles.
